A) YERLEŞMEYE GELEN KIBRIS ASILLI VE YABANCI UYRUKLU KİŞİLERİN İTHAL EDECEKLERİ ARAÇLARLA İLGİLİ TÜZÜK MADDESİ

(Binek Otomobilleri Yaş Sınırlandırılması Tüzüğü:)

(1) Kuzey Kıbrıs Türk Cumhuriyeti'ne, yerleşmek amacı ile gelen kişilerin ithal ettikleri binek otomobilleri (Gümrük Vergiler Tarife Yasasında Ek II. Cetvelde 87.03.21 - 87.03.90 pozisyonunda sınıflandırılan Binek Otomobilleri (Jeep, Land – Rover ve benzeri tipteki araçlar ile steysin vagonlar dahil) ve 87.11 pozisyonunda sınıflandırılan motosikletler) ümruklere geldiği zaman 3 (üç) yaşını doldurmuş olmaları halinde bu araçlara ithal izni verilmez.

Ancak, mucbir sebepler, hava muhalefeti, yolculuk esnasında hastalık ve kaza gibi umulmayan haller nedeni ile KKTC Gümrük Limanlarına geldikleri zaman 3(üç) yaşını doldurmuş olan Binek Otomobilleri ve Motosikletlereö gecikme süresini üç ayı aşmaması koşuluyla Bakanlığın önerisi ve Bakanlar Kurulu'nun onayı ile ithal izni verebilir.

(1.1) Yerleşmeye gelen kişilerin, (1)'inci fıkrada öngörülen haktan faydalanabilmeleri için, ülkeye yerleşmek amacı ile giriş yaptıkları tarihten en geç bir yıl içerisinde başvuruda bulunmaları gerekir.

(1.2) Yerleşmeye gelen kişilerin, KKTC'ne son giriş tarihinden itibaren en az 5 yıl önce yurt dışında buldukları ülkede adlarına kayıtlı Binek Otomobilleri ve Motosikletleri için (1)'nci fıkradaki yaş sınırı aranmaz.

(2) Bu madde amaçları bakımından “Yerleşmeye gelen kişi” Devletten 10 yıl uzakta kalmış ve yeniden devlete göç etmiş, devamlı yerleşmek amacıyla geldiğini ve yerleştiğini beyan eden 18 yaşını doldurmuş Kıbrıs asıllı kişileri (10 yılın hesaplanmasında üniversite veya yüksek okulda lisans eğitiminde geçirilen öğrencilik süreleri dikkate alınmaz) ve; Devlete devamlı olarak yerleşmek amacıyla gelen yerleştiğini resmi belgelerle kanıtlayan 18 yaşını doldurmuş geliri tamamıyla dış ülkelere temin edilen ve Devlette hiçbir işle iştigal etmeyen Kıbrıs Asıllı olmayan yabancı uyruklu kişiler ile K.K.T.C.'de yerleşik bulunan ve daha önce böyle bir ithal hakkından yararlanmayan Kıbrıs Asıllı olmayan yabancı kişileri anlatır.”

3) Bu madde kapsamındaki kişilerin maddede öngörülen haktan faydalanabilmesi için ülkeye yerleşmek amacı ile giriş yaptıkları tarihten itibaren en geç bir yıl içerisinde başvuruda bulunmaları gerekir.

B) YERLEŞMEYE GELEN KIBRIS ASILLI VE YABANCI UYRUKLU KİŞİLERİN İTHAL EDECEKLERİ EŞYALARLA İLGİLİ TÜZÜK MADDELERİ.

**IMPORT CONDITIONS OF NON COMMERCIAL PET ANIMALS FROM UK
TO TURKISH REPUBLIC OF NORTHERN CYPRUS**

These notes provide guidance for the exporter. They are based on the requirements for the importation of non commercial pet animals into Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC). We advise exporters to seek full details of the export requirements from the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (DEFRA) or Scottish Executive Environment and Rural Affairs Department (SEERAD).

GENERAL (common) CONDITIONS for ALL SPECIES

- 1) Failure to comply with any of the following conditions stated in this document will result in refusal of animals entering the country.
- 2) Importer should fully and carefully read this document. A declaration on acceptance of the conditions will be necessary at the stage of application.
- 3) It is necessary to obtain an IMPORT LICENCE from the Directorate of TRNC Veterinary Department before exporting the animal(s) from the UK.
- 4) According to the existing *Green Line Regulation* it is not allowed to move live animals between north and south part of Cyprus. Therefore, live animals can only be imported from North Cyprus port/airport.
- 5) You are required to complete and return the Application Form (PIB.01) to TRNC Veterinary Department to acquire the Import Licence. This form can be obtained from the Directorate of TRNC Veterinary department or diplomatic representatives of the TRNC in the UK.
- 6) The Import Licence is valid for 60 days.
- 7) Animals should have a health examination 48 hours prior to export and exporter must get an Export Health Certificate issued by DEFRA / SEERAD.
- 8) The crate containing your animal must be of international standards i.e. it must be large enough to permit the animal to stand in a natural position, turn around and lie down.
- 9) All costs including transfer, quarantine, extended quarantine (if applied), vaccination or treatment fees, must be paid by the owners of the animal prior to collection after quarantine.
- 10) Veterinary Department will not accept any liability for sickness or death of animal(s) whilst in quarantine.
- 11) The above conditions also apply to the individual species import conditions
- 12) Directorate has the right to change the import conditions according to the animal health status in country of origin and TRNC.

IMPORT OF DOGS AND CATS FROM GREAT BRITAIN TO TURKISH REPUBLIC OF NORTHERN CYPRUS

A) CONDITIONS PRIOR TO IMPORT

- 1) Cats and dogs subjected to export must not be less than 3 months old and rabies vaccination must be given at least 30 days and not more than 12 months prior to export.
- 2) Animal(s) should also be vaccinated or given booster vaccinations for other infectious diseases before export from country of origin.
 - Necessary vaccinations for dogs: Parvo, Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospira .
 - Necessary vaccinations for cats : Feline enteritis, feline influenza
- 3) To acquire import licence it is necessary to forward the following documents to the TRNC Veterinary department by any means.
 - a. Completed Application Form (PIB.01)
 - b. *Certificate of Vaccination Against Rabies for Dogs and Cats Intent for Export (EXA 25)* issued by DEFRA / SEERAD

- c. *Copies of vaccination certificates for other diseases.*
 - d. Laboratory Rabies Test Report from EU recognised blood testing laboratories.
(Indicating the rabies antibody titre greater or equal to 0.5 I.U./ml.)
- 4) After receipt of the above documents, Veterinary Directorate will issue (if applicable) and forward an import licence (PIR.01) to the exporter.
 - 5) Animals must have a health examination 48 hours prior to export and the exporter must get an Export Health Certificate (4891 EHC) issued by DEFRA / SEERAD.
 - 6) Originals of the documents stated below must accompany the animal(s) and be presented upon arrival in the TRNC.
 - Import Licences issued by Directorate of TRNC Veterinary Services (PIR.01)
 - Rabies vaccination certificate issued by DEFRA / SEERAD (EXA 25)
 - Laboratory Rabies Test Reports, from an approved laboratory
 - Export Health Certificate issued by DEFRA / SEERAD (4891 EHC)
 - 7) The crate containing your animal must be of appropriate International Air Transport Association (IATA) standards, i.e. it must be large enough to permit the animal to stand in a natural position, turn around and lie down.

B) CONDITIONS ON and AFTER ARRIVAL

- 1) Failure to comply with any stipulated condition will result in refusal of the animal(s) entry into the T.R.N.C.
- 2) Such animals are either re-exported or destroyed and its owner will be prosecuted. Serious offences may be tried by court. It is thus important to ensure that all necessary documentation accompanies the animals.
- 3) On arrival to T.R.N.C. , the animal(s) will be collected by the official Veterinarians or Veterinary Technicians from airport/port as soon as possible
- 4) Dogs and cats will on arrival be subject to quarantine for between one month up to a maximum of six months from the date of landing (General attitude in normal conditions is one month).
- 5) The period of detention may be extended beyond the normal period in the event of:
 - an outbreak of rabies occurring at the quarantine premises; or
 - Your animal is sharing accommodation with another animal(s) and one of these animals should die.
- 6) In the event of the animal sharing accommodation with other animal or other animals and those animals becoming rabid during the period of their detention and isolation in quarantine, the Department may require the animal to be put to sleep.
- 7) If the animal dies in quarantine the Veterinary Department may take, or require to be taken, such action as is considered necessary to determine whether or not the animal was infected with rabies at the time of its death and may dispose of the remains of the animal, or require them to be disposed of, in such manner as the Department thinks fit.
- 8) Worming treatment (containing praziquantel) will be given to the animals in quarantine under the supervision of the owners.
- 9) Owners are responsible of feeding of their animals. In case of necessity, staff in quarantine department can takeover the responsibility of feeding the animal.
- 10) Owners can visit their animals in quarantine daily in designated visiting hours.
- 11) In the quarantine period, if needed, health checks, vaccinations or treatment can be performed only by official veterinarians.

IMPORT CONDITIONS OF CAPTIVE BIRDS

- 1) To acquire import licence it is necessary to forward below documents to TRNC Veterinary Services.
 - a. Completed Application Form (PIB.01)

- b. Veterinary Health Certificate.
 - Bird(s) should be free from infectious or contagious diseases including Newcastle and highly pathogenic avian influenza (fowl plague) and,
 - The premises of origin must not be situated in an area subject to restriction due to these diseases.
- 2) After receipt of the above documents, the Veterinary Directorate will issue (if applicable) and forward an import licence (PIR.01) to the exporter.
- 3) Bird(s) should have an examination 48 hours prior to export and exporter must get an Export Health Certificate (4282 EHC) issued by DEFRA / SEERAD.
- 4) Originals of the documents stated below must accompany the animal(s) and be presented upon arrival.
 - Import Licences issued by Directorate of TRNC Veterinary Services (PIR.01)
 - Export Health Certificate issued by DEFRA / SEERAD (4282 EHC)
 - Veterinary Health Certificate.
- 5) Failure to comply with any stipulated condition will result in refusal of the animal(s) entry into the T.R.N.C.
- 6) Such animals are either re-exported or destroyed and its owner will be prosecuted. Serious offences may be tried by court. It is thus important to ensure that all necessary documentation accompanies the animals.
- 7) On arrival to T.R.N.C., the bird(s) will be collected by the official Veterinarians or Veterinary Technicians from airport/port as soon as possible.
- 8) Bird(s) will on arrival be subject to home quarantine for at least 20 days from the date of landing.
- 9) On arrival *Pet Import and Quarantine Form* (PIK.01) will be filled out and necessary fees will be paid by importer. If bird(s) arrive out of working hours, the importer will be invited to complete the filing transaction on the first working day.
- 10) Birds will be kept in known premises separately and will not come in contact with any other animals. Bird(s) can only move to other premises with the permission of directorate of Veterinary Department. Veterinary officials have right to visit the premises in question any time without informing the owner.
- 11) It is an obligation to inform Veterinary Department in case of any occurring diseases in quarantine period.
- 12) Directorate of Veterinary Department reserve the right to keep the bird(s) in the Department's quarantine section, or to move bird(s) from home quarantine to department quarantine and extend the quarantine period. In such cases additional fees will be paid by the owner.
- 13) The Veterinary Department will not be liable for the sickness or deaths of animals in quarantine.

IMPORT CONDITIONS FOR OTHER PET ANIMALS

- 1) For the non commercial other pet animals, it is also necessary to apply for import licence as dogs, cats and captive birds.
- 2) A Veterinary Health Certificate will be attached to the application form and forwarded to Directorate of TRNC Veterinary Department.
- 3) You will be informed about quarantine method, quarantine period and import conditions designated by Veterinary Department according to the species and other conditions.
